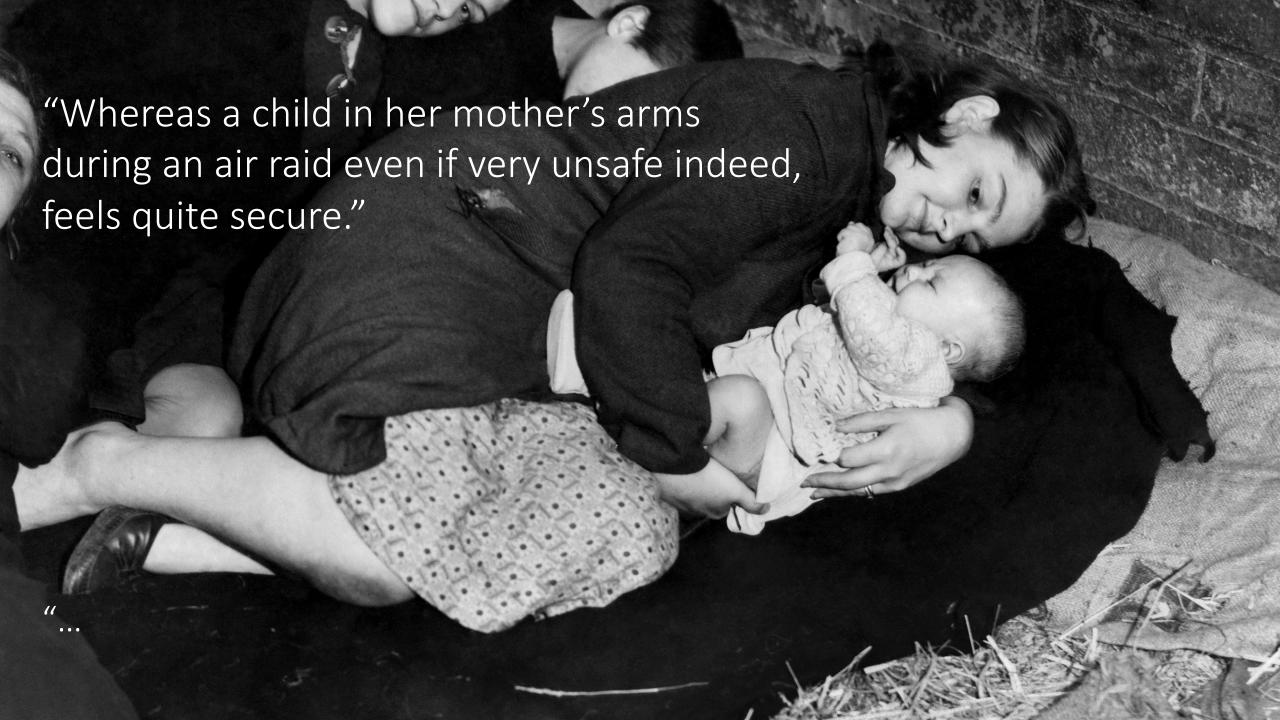


"How can you speak of a climate of safety when death is the most unsafe thing that can happen?"

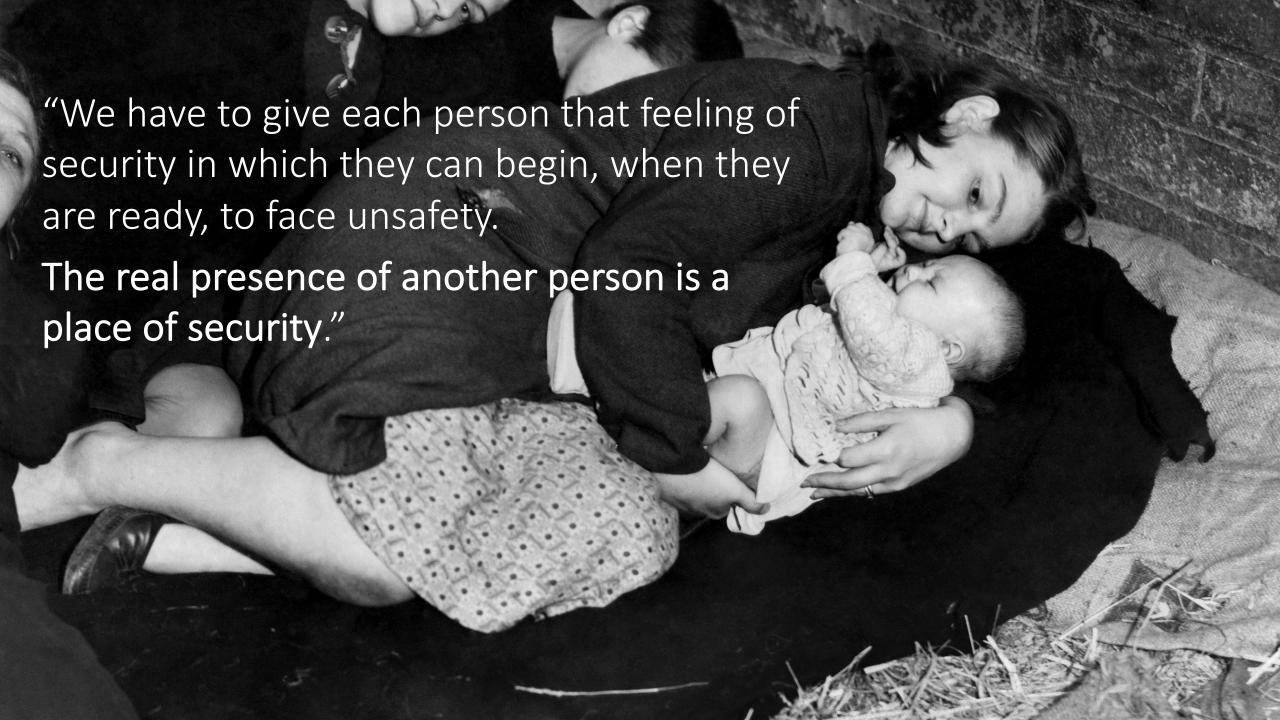
#### "Security"
