PRAYERS FOR THE DEAD

Prayers for the dead, and working spiritually for the dead, formed a very great part of the Céile Dé tradition in ancient times. Life circumstances always brings us times when it may be a practice that we are called to engage in, either alone or as a part of a Céile Dé group.

This prayer in Irish Gaelic is typical of what is traditionally chanted within the three day period immediately after someone has passed over. It is, as the words show, a blessing to aid the soul on its journey. It is also traditionally sung at Samhain time.

The style, if sung in a group is that of call and response.



A PSALMS DEVOTIONAL ON THE PASSAGE OF A BELOVED

The Early Christians borrowed a practice from their Jewish ancestors after the passing of a special beloved person. Psalm 119 (the longest of the psalms) was written to honor the passage of the Jewish people from Babylon to Jerusalem. Each verse corresponds to a different day and step in this journey that also represents the journey of a person from death to new life. The first verse of the psalm, 'Blessed are those on the way' speaks to those who are on the way between this world and the next.




Early Celtic Christians formed special communities with the sole purpose of praying the psalms for persons who have died. The tradition evolved to pray Psalm 119 each day for a year following the death of a beloved. The person who agreed to do the prayer for the deceased was called an 'anam aire,' meaning eternal soul friend. Women's spiritual communities of the times especially dedicated themselves to this practice.





In the middle ages, hospices grew up all over Europe not only to tend to the sick and dying but also as centers of prayer and support for family members of the deceased. The tradition continued to pray the Book Psalms, one psalm a day, for an entire year after a person's passing. Doing this meant that a family member would be agreeing to pray through the entire Book of 150 Psalms about twice during the first memorial year.



There is a modern revival of Praying with the Psalms for a beloved soul. Nan Merrill's translation is especially accessible because her term for God is 'the Beloved.' This language can enable the person praying to relate both to the Divine and to their own personal relationship with a beloved soul. One way of praying the psalms is through a daily devotional practice (usually before bedtime) in order to be in spiritual communion with the person who died. One could either pray the entire psalm 119 each day or, move through it reflectively one verse per day. Journaling afterwards can add a deeper reflection as we recall our everlasting love and connection with the departed.

Teach me the way of discernment that I make choices with integrity. In your steadfast Love, may I know the joy of responsibility for all my deeds. Give me courage for all the trials, testings, and training as I choose the spiritual life. Breathe on me, O Breath of Inspiration, in the silence of my tranquil heart, infill me with your wisdom. O, that I might radiate the compassion and peace, the truth and beauty of the Beloved! Direct my steps, O Holy One, that I may humbly walk with You. The witness of your Life is my model; therefore my soul yearns for You. The unfolding of your Way gives light; It imparts understanding to the simple. My mouth pours forth praise continually, for I am ever grateful for your Promises. You come to me and are gracious to me, as You are to all who open their heart's door. Guide my steps according to your Wisdom, and show me how to lovingly co-create with You. Let me not be lured by the world's values, that I may walk the path of wholeness. May your face shine upon your friend, as You teach me of Love. I weep over our wounded world,

our earth ravaged by greedy, insensitive hands.

For You are loving, kind, and gentle; In You are all blessings. Let me not be deaf to your Voice, nor suffer the pain of a rebellious soul. Gentle me, O Loving Guide, that I may learn the wisdom of purity, patience, and peace. Teach me of mercy, O You who are the merciful One, that my soul may serve with You joyfully and with love. O friends, open your heart to the divine life! Attune yourself to the Divine Guest within your Being! For, when you come to know the Source of your life, love flows through you and radiates outward; Harmony enters into your life, you see with new eyes. All that once brought pain and suffering no longer affects the peace in your heart.

Through the healing forgiveness of Love, all past wrongs are righted; Joy comes alive in your heart, the joy of understanding. Then do you know the great Treasure, the pearl hidden in the Secret Realm within. Glorious is the life of the soul when illumined by the Divine Spirit. Search for it, friends, count not the years; Enter into the stillness of your innermost being! Abandon yourself to the Beloved, draw closer and closer to Love. For when you dwell in peace within Love's heart, and know the Divine Spirit in your own heart, You become as nothing, yet all things are yours. As you radiate the healing love of your inmost Being into a suffering, scarred, yet ever-sacred world, Offer grateful praise from the Chalice of your heart to the One who loves through you. Great peace have those who co-create with You, who share the living wine of your Spirit. They know that all goodness comes from your Divine Love, the Source and Foundation of all life. Fill us, O Gracious One, with your loving wisdom, guide all hearts on paths of peace. When the journey seems long, when we become discouraged along the way, You uphold and sustain us, You restore us with your blessed grace. When we stumble and stray amid the thorns on false paths, we are ever humbled by your forgiving Love. You welcome us home as honored guests, back into the fold of your Heart. Under these conditions the consolation of the living in the loss of the loved one is touching. The old people speak of 'bas sona' with exultant satisfaction, and would wish above all things on earth that 'bas sona' may be their own portion when the time comes for them to go ...

The Circling Prayer and Blessing

S

This blessing is traditionally used for new born children and at the end of life. It is also appropriate for use by an anamcara before a profound spiritual encounter such as a spiritual direction session or a period of guided visualization. A candle may be lit and used to circle the head of the person to be blessed.

The anamcara circles with the candle in a counter clock-wise direction saying:

Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep harm without Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep evil without Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep strife without Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep lies without Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep hatred without.

Anyone may name something they wish to be kept without.


The anamcara circles in a clock-wise direction saying :

Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep peace within Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep love within Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep trust within Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep truth within Circle *her/him*, Lord, keep good within.

Anyone may name something they wish to be kept within.

Conclude the blessing with the following invitation:

May you have the commitment to know what has hurt you., to allow it to come close to you, and in the end, to become one with you. Amen.



This practice is useful when an anamcara experiences sleeplessness and anxiety (which often can occur between 2-3 in the morning). The simple practice creates a space to honor our concerns while circling them in love and light. The focus can be on our own needs or the needs of another (anamcara) whom we would like to bless.

ANTIPHONS AND PRAYERS

1) DEUS MISERICORS

Merciful God, gentle God, you who restrain the multitude of your mercies through no law of time, and do not turn away those who knock at the door of your compassion, even at the very end of life, look down favorably on your servant, ______, begging in the full confession of the heart remission of all his/her sins. Renew in him/her most Holy Father, whatever has been violated through evil deceit and restore the member, perfected through forgiveness, to the unity of the body of your Church.

Responses: O God you give to the penitent courage to face the darkness of sin. You are Lord and there is no other. We pray for this whole family that they may be cleansed from all form of sickness and evil.

2) EMITTE DOMINE

Lord, send down from heaven the Holy Spirit, your Divine Paraclete into this pure olive oil which you have seen fit to produce from living wood for the restoration of the body, so that through your holy benediction it may be a defender of the body to all using it as an ointment, drinking or touching it, for the ridding of all pains, all weaknesses, and every sickness of the body; your holy Chrism, Lord, blessed by you, from which you anointed prophets, kings and martyrs, remaining in our inmost parts.

[The Lord's Prayer follows: Knowing, Lord, that you are joined with us even in times of tears, hear us now as we pray. "Our Father...]

3) SI QUISQUIS

If anyone among you is suffering hardship let them pray. If a person is in good spirits, he should sing a hymn of praise. Is there anyone sick among you? They should ask for the elders of the church. They in turn are to pray over them, anointing them with oil in the Name of the Lord. This prayer uttered in faith will reclaim the one who is ill and the Lord will restore him to health. If they have committed any sins, they will be likewise forgiven. Hence, declare your sins to one another and pray for one another that you may find healing. The fervent petition of the holy person is powerful indeed.

Trust the promise given to all who confess the mercy of Christ that, "this day you will be with me in paradise." May the Holy Deipara intercede for you as you journey into Life Everlasting.

[Anoint the crown of the head] May you no longer seek to control your fate or destiny but yield to the just Plan of the Creator. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

[Anoint mouth] May you be delivered from the tides of impatience that rip at both body and soul. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

[Anoint ears] May you be delivered from the stain of sinful pride which caused the demons to fall. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

[Anoint between the shoulders] May you no longer know the pangs of envy and covetousness. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

[Anoint the eyes] May you release all that moth can eat and rust can corrode. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

[Anoint the forehead] May your appetites now be quieted so that you only desire the true and living water. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

[Anoint hands and feet] May you be found awake and keeping vigil so that when the bridegroom comes you may be found waiting. Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on us.

Deliver the soul of your child from all falsehood and fear, bring him/her to the true home of heaven with the courts of saints who having been tried by fire have been found worthy.

- 6) ASPERGES: Cleanse this place of sin that all who dwell here may be purified. Wash us and we shall become whiter than the snows.
- 7) BAPTISMATI: [Recited during washing with blessed water] You have already been washed in the bath of regeneration. No one can see the reign of God unless they are begotten from above, without being reborn of water and the spirit. Flesh begets flesh but spirit begets spirit. [Cf. John 3]

- 8) AVE CRUX: May I never boast of anything save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ through whom the world is crucified to me and I to the world. [Gal 6:14]
- 9) PASTOR BONUS: Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil. Your word, O Lord, is a lamp for my feet and a light for my path.
- 10) REQUIEM AETERNAM: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let your perpetual light shine on them.
- 11) EXTINGUE: Extinguish in him/her, Lord, the heat of lusts and fevers, destroy the torture of vices and sting of pains, dissolve the torment of desire and sickness, suppress the swelling of pride and tumors, empty the rottenness of vanity and ulcers, calm the inside of the entrails and the heart, remove the scars of conscience and wounds, put in order the works of the flesh and the material of the blood and grant him/her forgiveness of sins.
- 12) SUBVENITE: Come down now saints of God, run towards him/her, angels of the Lord. Taking his/her soul and offering it in the sight of the Most High.
- 13) DEUS APUD QUEM: God in whom all mortal things live, to whom our bodies do not perish by dying but are changed into something better, as supplicants we entreat You to order the soul of your servant, ______, to be gathered up through the hands of the blessed angels, led into the bosom of your friend Abraham, the patriarch, and resuscitated on the last day of the Great Judgment. Through the indulgence of Your piety, wash away whatever under the sway of the devil, may have done in this world contrary to You.
- 14) SUSCIPE: [part 1] Receive the soul of your servant, clothe it in heavenly vestments and wash it in the holy font of eternal life.
- 15) PIO RECORDATIONIS AFFECTU: In the pious activity of remembrance, most dear brethren, let us commemorate our dear brother/sister, _____, whom the Lord has called from the temptations of the world, begging the mercy of our God, so that He himself may deign to grand him/her a quiet and pleasant dwelling, that He may remit all the offenses of momentary thoughtlessness, that having been granted the grace of full indulgence for whatsoever his/her own.
- 16) TE DOMINE: We pray for the soul of your servant whom you have ordered to be brought from the abyss of this world. Raise him/her up with your saints and elected ones, erase his/her crimes down to the last penny. Raise his/her soul up with you in immortality, O Lord!
- 17) SUSCIPE: [parts 2/3] Receive, Lord, the soul of your servant, ______, in his/her eternal home and grant peace in the celestial city, Jerusalem. Grant him/her a place in the first resurrection, let him/her rise to receive a new body and come with the blessed into eternal life.
- 18) EXORCISM: Depart from this place, powers of darkness and troublemakers of the soul. Cleanse us with water and light. Depart spirits of death and illness; come to purify us with the mantle of eternal holiness. May this place be restored to your Peace, O Eternal Friend of our Soul.

- 19) IN PARADISUUM: May the angels lead you into paradise; may the martyrs welcome you to the new and holy city, Jerusalem. May a chorus of angels lift you up with Lazarus, who once was poor, into the holy city, Jerusalem, and may you together enjoy eternal rest.
- 20) DE TERRA FORMASTI ME: You ordered me to be born O Lord and out of the earth you formed me. Do not forget your servant now in his/her poverty. [Book of Job]
- 21) DEBITUM CONDITIONIS HUMANI: The debt of our human condition has now been paid. Having suffered the fate of illness, weakness and death, just as the Lord himself knew in his human body, may he/she now be given the Holy Spirit in hope of resurrection with the entire society of the Holy Ones who now reign with God.
- 22) APERITE MIHI PORTAS: Open now the gates of justice and let me in. For I have confessed the name of the Lord. The just ones will enter by the everlasting gate.
